Unless specifically admitted in their Answer, Respondents denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted the following defenses, among others: the Statement of Claim fails to state a cause of action upon which relief can be granted; contributory negli; sence or omissions; proximate cause; Claimants, by their conduct, approved and/or ratified Respondents' actions; Claimants are barred from recovery by the doctrines of waiver and estopped; statutes of limitations; assumption of the risk; and Claimants have no standing to bring individual claims
